Union Jack Bunting

Description:

Union Jack Knitted Bunting, knitted in DK wool.

The flags can be knitted in either stocking stitch or garter stitch or a combination of both, you need 10 flags for the 2.6m length. If a longer length is required add more flags.

Finished Dimensions:

Stocking Stitch Flag : Max 19cm wide x 13cm deep

Garter Stitch Flag : Max 15cm wide x 15cm deep

Bunting Overall Length: Approx 2.6 m long with 10 flags and Union Jack

Materials:

Blue, White and Red DK yarn

1 x 4.00mm knitting needles,

1 x 4.00mm circular for tape knitting needles,

Tension:

Not important for this pattern.

Union Jack:

- 1. Cast on 67 stitches.
- 2. Follow chart using either Fair Isle or Intarsia techniques as preferred.
- Note: 1st row of Union Jack is a Knit row
- 3. With RS facing cast off.

Stocking stitch Flag:

- 1. Cast on 41 sts on size 4.00mm needles.
- 2. Work in st st throughout. Starting with a knit row, Knit 1 row.
- 3. Purl 1 row
- 4. Row 1: Every knit row K1, SL1K K1 PSSO, knit to last 3stitches K2tog TBL, K1.
- 5. Row 2: Every Purl row P to end.
- 6. Repeat rows 1 and 2 until 5 stitches remain.
- 7. With RS facing K1 K3tog, K1
- 8. With WS facing P3tog, pull yarn through last loop to finish off

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Garter stitch Flag:

- 1. Cast on 41 sts on size 4.00mm needles.
- 2. Work in Knit throughout. Starting with a knit row, Knit 2 rows.
- 3. Row 1: K1, SL1K K1 PSSO, knit to last 3stitches K2tog TBL, K1.
- 4. Row 2: Knit to end
- 5. Repeat rows 1 and 2 until 5 stitches remain.
- 6. With RS facing K1 K3tog, K1
- 7. With WS facing K3tog, pull yarn through last loop to finish off

Hanging tape:

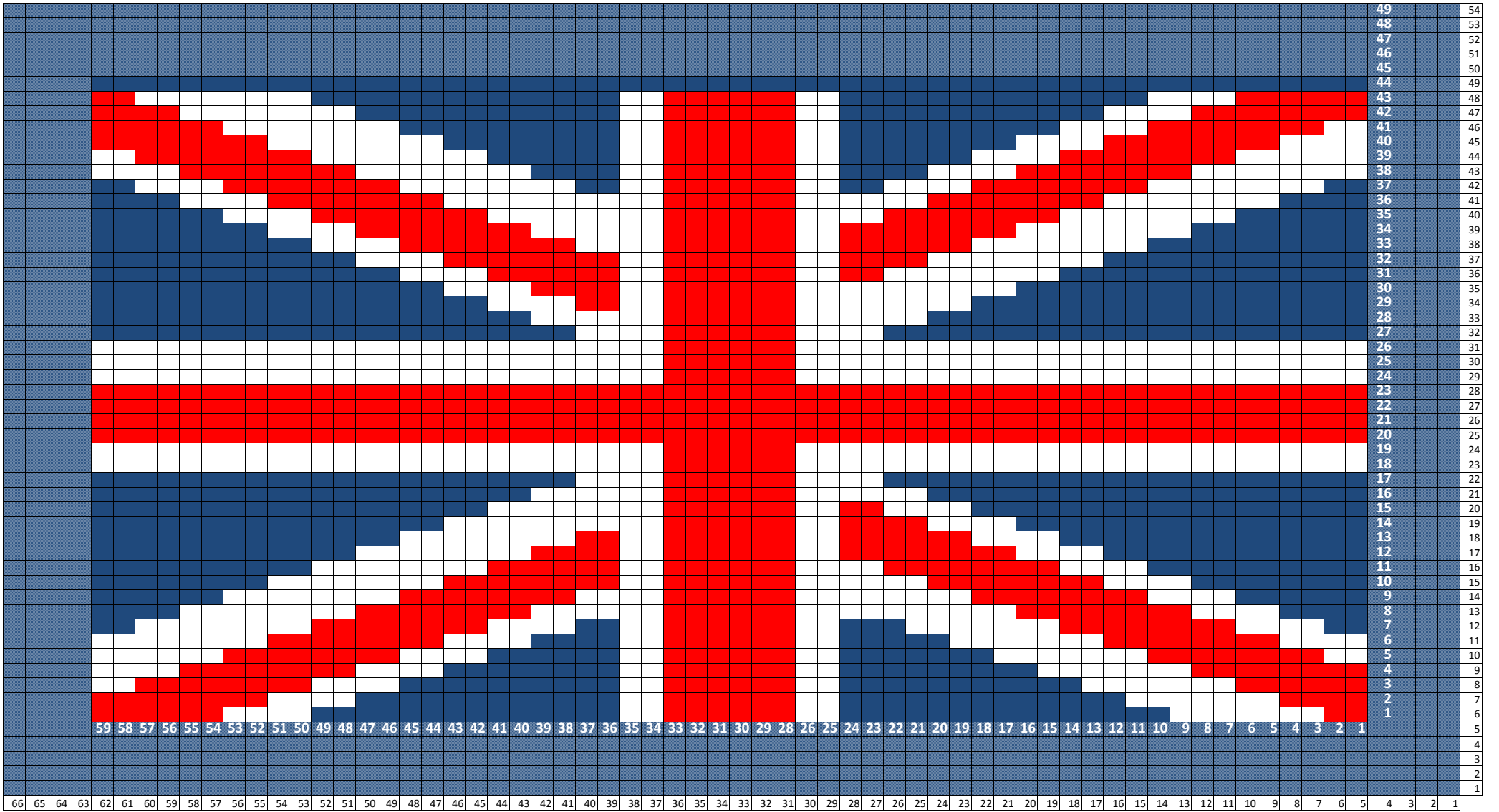
- 1. Using 4mm circular needle cast on 50 stitches.
- 2. With RS facing. Pick up 41 stitches from each flag. Cast on 5 stitches to give a tape between flags.
- 3. Repeat step 2 for 5 flags (or number of flags being positioned).
- 4. Pick up 67 from Union Jack, cast on 5 stitches.
- 5. Pick up 41 stitches from each flag. Cast on 5 stitches to give a tape between flags
- 6. Repeat step 5 for the remaining 5 flags (or number of flags being positioned).
- 7. Cast on 50 stitches.
- 8. Knit 4 rows in garter stitch.
- 9. With WS facing cast off purlwise.

Finishing off:

- 1. With RS facing and right hand end of tape, fold first 10 stitches behind tape and sew to WS of the tape to give a loop for hanging, repeat by reversing instructions for other end.
- 2. Sew a strengthening stitch at each side of the flag where the first and last flag stitch joins the tape.
- 3. Darn in all loose ends.
- 4. Block and press as directed on ball band.

Abbreviations

K	knitting	TOG	together
P	purl	TBL	through back of loops
ST(S)	stitch(es)	BEG	beginning
GARTER ST	every row knit	ALT	alternate
ST ST	1 row knit, 1 row purl (stocking stitch)	REP	repeat
REM	remain(ing)	SL1K	slip 1 knitways
RS	right side	PSSO	pass slipped stitch over
WS	wrong side	PATT	pattern
