Baby Blanket

Description:

Baby blanket knitted in stocking stitch with a garter stitch border.

Finished Dimensions:

Blanket: Approx 68cm long x 49cm wide.

Materials:

4 x 50gm balls Rowan Purelife Organic Cotton – Colour **A** -Oak Bark - 995

1 x 50gm balls Cotton DK – Colour **B** – **contrast colour**

1 pair 3.75mm knitting needle,

Tension:

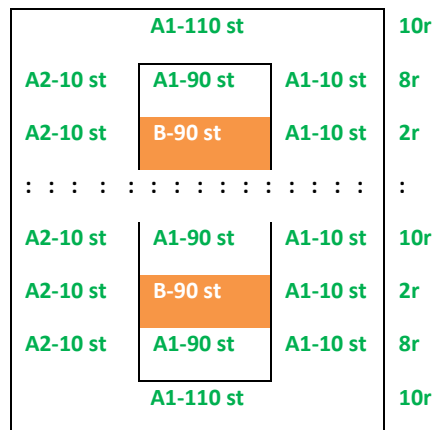
3.75mm needles – 22 stitches by 30 rows to 10cm tension square using st st although tension is not import for this project.

Pattern 1

- Row 1. Using 1st ball of **A** K10, K90, Using 2nd ball of **A** K10
- Row 2. Using 2nd ball of **A** K10, Using 1st of **A** P90, K10

Pattern 2

- Row 1. Using 1st ball of **A** K10, using colour **B** K90, Using 2nd ball of **A** K10
- Row 2. Using 2nd ball of **A** K10, using colour **B** P90, Using 1st ball of **A** K10



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Blanket

- 1. Cast on 110 stitches
- 2. Knit every row for 10 rows
- 3. RS. Knit Pattern 1, 4 times
- 4. Knit Pattern 2, once
- 5. Knit Pattern 1, 5 times
- 6. Repeat rows 4 and 5, 16 times
- 7. Knit Pattern 1, 4 times
- 8. Knit every row for 10 rows
- 9. Darn in all loose ends.

TIPS... *Also carry contrast yarn up the side otherwise you will have lots of ends to weave in.- don't forget to twist yarn around the other ball at the changeover of yarn or you will end up with holes.*

Abbreviations

K	knitting	TOG	together
P	purl	TBL :	through back of loops
ST(S)	stitch(es)	BEG	beginning
GARTER ST	every row knit	ALT :	alternate
ST ST	1 row knit, 1 row purl (stocking stitch)	REP :	repeat
REM	remain(ing)	SL1K	slip 1 knitways
RS :	right side	PSSO	pass slipped stitch over
WS :	wrong side	PATT	pattern
