Cupcake

Description:

Knitted cupcake with sprinkles and removable cake case

Finished Dimensions:

Approx 9cm high x 9 cm wide.

Materials:

3.5mm needles

Small amount of Pink (Shade A), Cerise (Shade B) and Light brown (Shade C) DK wool or shades of your choice

Beads or Glass Headed pins for sprinkles

Tension:

Not important for this project

Cupcake

- Using shade C cast on 10 stitches
- Row 1. (k1, inc1) to end (15 stitches)
- Row 2. P
- Row 3. (k2, inc1) to end (20 stitches)
- Row 4. P
- Row 5. (K2, inc1) to last two stitches K2 (26 stitches)
- Row 6. P
- Row 7. K1 (K3, Inc 1) to last stitch K1 (32 stitches)
- Row 8. P
- Row 9. K
- Row 10. P
- Row 11. K
- Row 12. P
- Row 13. K4 (K1, inc1, k6) three times, K4 (35 stitches)
- Row 14. P
- Row 15. K
- Row 16. P
- Row 17. K4 (K1, Inc 1, K7) three times, K4 (38 stitches)
- Row 18. P
- Row 19. K4 (K1, Inc 1, K4) five times, K4 (43 stitches)
- Row 20. P
- Row 21. Change to Shade A. K
- Row 22. P
- Row 23. K
- Row 24. P
- Row 25. K2, (K2tog 5 times, K10) twice, K1 (33 stitches)
- Row 26. P

- Row 27. K1 (K2 tog 3 times, K7) twice, K2 tog three times, (24 stitches)
- Row 28. P
- Row 29. K2 tog to end (12 stitches)
- Row 30. P2 tog to end (6 stitches)
- Row 31. Break yarn and thread through stitches, draw tight & fasten off

Cherry

- Using shade B cast on 4 stitches
- Row 1. P
- Row 2. P
- Row 3. K
- Row 4. P
- Row 5. K
- Row 6. P
- Row 7. P
- Row 8. K2 tog to end
- Row 9. Break yarn and thread through stitches, draw tight & fasten off

Case

- Using shade B cast on 9 stitches
- Rows 1 – 78 Knit all rows in Garter Stitch
- Cast Off.
- Pick up 29 stitches evenly along one of the long sides
- Row 1. P
- Row 2. K4 (K2 tog x 4 , K3) twice, K4
- Row 3. P
- Row 4. K1 (K2 tog, K2) to end (16 stitches)
- Row 5. P
- Row 6. K2 tog to end (8 stitches)
- Row 7. Break yarn and thread through stitches, draw tight & fasten off
- Sew bottom and side together to form a cupcake case

Making Up

- Sew together cupcake edges leaving a gap to stuff. Stuff with stuffing and sew up gap. For all pieces darn in loose ends.
- Sew a running stitch around edge of cherry and pull tight to give a ball shape. Fasten off and attach to top of cake.
- Use pins or sew on small round beads to replicate sprinkles.

Abbreviations

K	knitting	TOG	together
P	purl	TBL	through back of loops
ST(S)	stitch(es)	BEG	beginning
GARTER ST	every row knit	ALT	alternate
ST ST	1 row knit, 1 row purl (stocking stitch)	REP	repeat
REM	remain(ing)	SL1K	slip 1 knitways
RS	right side	PSSO	pass slipped stitch over
WS	wrong side	INC 1	knit into front and back of next stitch

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
